The map in your hands shows activities for you to do on your own. Some of them have to be done in places marked with numbers on the map, while the tasks marked with a bird symbol can be performed in any place in the gardens.

The poem “Chirp, chirp” will brighten your trip or rest in the company of birds from our garden.

-  Spread your arms like wings. Try to change into birds.
-  Stop for a moment and listen to birds singing. Maybe you’ll hear the cries of coots, chasing intruders away from the ponds?

-  Walk the alleys proud like peacocks.
-  Try to see young birds in tree crowns and look for thrushes and robins in the thicket.
-  Dance like little chicks.

THE BIRD ROUTE



1. Find a column with an eagle located somewhere in our gardens. Did you know that the eagle is a symbol of majesty, dignity, power and might?

2. What are birds' houses called? You can find them near the Myślewicki Palace, on the "Mouse Hill" behind the Amphitheatre, and by the Old Guardhouse. Do birds visit them?

3. Look for the metal woodpecker near the Museum of Hunting and Horsemanship and cheerfully patter with it.
