Bring your whole family and find all the secrets of the historical interiors and gardens of the Royal Łazienki Museum! The following tips will help you plan your visit:

THE PALACE ON THE ISLE

Take an audio-guide*. Walk through the Bathing Room decorated with white-and-blue tiles. See the three-headed dog Cerberus in the Ballroom, and find the 18th-century chocolates with King Stanisław August's monogram in the Royal Bedroom.

THE OLD ORANGERY

Stand in the box of the unique **Royal Theatre**. In the Sculpture Gallery look for the objects that can be touched (e.g. the statue of Eros). Imagine being like the court artists and draw something in the sketchbooks available in the Orangery.

THE WHITE PAVILION*

In the tangle of grotesques painted on the walls in the Dining Room try to find the symbols representing the four continents: an elephant, a camel, an ostrich, and a horse. Before entering the Bedroom, note the gold-plated door handle and its untypical shape.

THE MYŚLEWICKI PALACE

Take a look at the paintings decorating the Central Room and instantly move to Rome or Venice. Feel the smell of the fragrant fountain. Don't miss the plafond depicting the mythological characters: Zephyr and Flora.

THE OLD GUARDHOUSE

Visit our education centre – a place for meetings and family workshops. Play, read, and create your own works of art. Take a rest on the soft pillow sacks. Here you will also find a place to feed small children and a changing table.

THE WATER TOWER*

Learn the water history of the Royal Łazienki. An educational map is available in the building – take it and follow the trail of ponds, fountains, and springs.

THE GARDEN

Track down peacocks, squirrels, and mandarin ducks. Count the stone lions. Discover exotic locations: the **Egyptian Temple** and the **Chinese Garden**. Take a seat in the audience of the **Amphitheatre** or rest in the resting area next to the **New Orangery** or the **Old Guardhouse**. Take part in workshops organised in the **Ecological Education Centre**.
