THE ROYAL ŁAZIENKI MUSEUM

The Royal Łazienki Museum is the former summer residence of King Stanisław August, the last king of Poland. Its origins date back to the seventeenth century, when a bathhouse pavilion – łaźnia – was built here at the behest of Stanisław Herakliusz Lubomirski. For centuries, the residence was a backdrop for the most important events related to the history of Poland.

The harmonious space, combining neoclassical architecture with historic gardens, will raise the prestige of many a celebration. You are invited to organize events in our unique interiors.

Individual clients can organize their wedding ceremony in the Ballroom of the Palace on the Isle or the King's Sculpture Gallery in the Old Orangery. The premises are not hired out for private parties, wedding celebrations, dinners, birthdays, anniversaries, etc.

THE PALACE ON THE ISLE

The Palace on the Isle is one of the most outstanding neoclassical monuments in Poland. We have a bright and spacious Ballroom with painted decorations and sculptures alluding to antiquity, the Salle de Salomon – with an interior elaborately decorated with gilding – which overlooks the pond and the bridge on Agrykola Street, as well as the Dining Room, where the famous Thursday dinners were once held.

Each of these interiors is unique in character. Original eighteenth-century decorations and ambient lighting create the perfect atmosphere for organizing a gala, business reception, concert or conference.

The splendid atmosphere of the king's summer residence will make your guests feel that they are special.

THE OLD ORANGERY

The Old Orangery is divided into the King's Sculpture Gallery and the Royal Theatre. The gallery's bright, spacious interior is the perfect venue to host an elegant dinner or a corporate cocktail party.

The theatre is ideal for hosting a gala, concert or conference. The original eighteenth-century interior not only has excellent acoustics, but also ambient lighting. The venue is complemented by the historic Orangery Garden.
